

Upgrade your Commercial Fishing Vessel USDA Grant Funding Available

Southwest Alaska Municipal Conference is working with **partners** to offer low-cost energy audits to commercial fishing vessels in Southwest Alaska. Fishing vessel upgrades that save energy are eligible for USDA grant funding.

Who's eligible for low-cost energy audits?

Commercial fishing vessels in the Aleutians, Bristol Bay, and Kodiak regions. You must live or dock in these regions to be eligible.

What is a targeted energy audit?

You tell us! Targeted audits identify energy savings and can focus on savings from installing:

- Refrigeration upgrades – including RSW systems;
- Variable speed pump motors or auxiliary engines;
- LED lighting;
- Insulation in fish hold; and more.

How much does an audit cost?

AUDIT TYPE	Fishing Vessels
Complexity of Systems (75% savings)	
Low	\$500*
Medium	\$625*
High	\$750*

Apply for the USDA REAP grant. If you're looking to install an RSW system, LED lighting, or more; you may be eligible for a grant covering 25% of the cost.
