Who's eligible for low-cost energy audits and REAP grants?

Small businesses, including owners and operators of office buildings, stores, restaurants, lodges, and warehouses in the Aleutians, Bristol Bay & Kodiak

What will an energy audit tell me?

You tell us! Audits may assess all energy uses in a building or target areas you are interested in. Targeted audits can focus on energy savings from:

- **LED lighting replacements**
- **Heating fuel conversion:** Propane or electric to heat pump, and more
- **HVAC upgrades:** Old boilers, inefficient ventilation systems, and more
- **Window replacements**
- **Higher efficiency appliances**
- **Insulation and air tightening**

Next step? Upgrade your building!

Apply for the USDA REAP grant. If you're looking to upgrade your building, you may be eligible for a grant covering 25% of the cost. We can work with you to complete the application process.

What will an energy audit cost me?

AUDIT TYPE	Level 1	Level 2
Building Size	Owner Cost (75% savings)	Owner Cost (75% savings)
Up to 6,000 ft ²	\$225	\$750*
Up to 10,000 ft ²	\$300	\$1,000*
Up to 20,000 ft ²	\$400	\$1,750*
Up to 30,000 ft ²	\$525	\$2,250*
Over 30,000 ft ²	Call or email for quote.	

*Level 2 audit is usually required to apply for a REAP improvement grant. Call or email for specific quotes based on building size and audit scope.
